TERMS AND CONDITIONS REGARDING SCHOOL FEES

1.
 - a. Biological/adoptive parents and who have legal custody and / or legal Guardianship or
 - b. a person who undertakes to fulfil the obligations of a parent (including, but not limited to a person who enrolls the learner) in respect of a learner are regarded as "parents" of the learner as envisaged in the South African Schools Act, and be liable to pay school fees accordingly. The word "parent" contained in this agreement, shall also include parents and person or persons liable for the payment of school fees.
2. The school fee department will at all times adhere to the following legislative framework:
 - a. South African Schools Act No 84 of 1996
 - b. Admission and school Fee Policy
 - c. Protection of Personal Information Act, no. 4 of 2013. ('POPIA')
3. We jointly and severally undertake to pay school fees and understand the following:
 - a. The annual school fees will be a compulsory sum per annum as adopted by the majority of parents at the budget meeting held annually .
 - b. In terms of the South African Schools Act, parents are jointly and severally liable for the payment of the school fees, irrespective of their marital status.
 - c. In the event of non-payment of school fees, the school will institute legal action against both parents irrespective of maintenance and divorce orders which may exist between the parties and shall the full year's school fees become due and payable with immediate effect.
 - d. In terms of Section 39 of the South African Schools Act, parents are liable to pay compulsory school fees.
 - e. In terms of Section 40 and 41 of the South African Schools Act, the school may enforce the payment of these compulsory fees.
 - f. If parents fail to meet their school fee obligations, the school may record this non- performance with a registered credit bureau/platform and the parents or persons who are liable for the payment of school fees consents to this information being so reported.
 - g. The parties to this application undertake to pay all legal costs, on an **attorney-and-client** basis, interest including attorney / client fees and collection costs incurred by the school, in the event of the school having to take legal action for the recovery of school fees.
 - h. Parents who are unable to pay school fees may apply for exemption of these fees. Applications must be submitted annually to the Chairperson of the Governing Body on/before the last school day of **Term 1**. Parents will be interviewed by members of the School Governing Body. The "combined annual gross income of parents" must be taken into consideration when considering an application for exemption. This means that the annual gross income of the parents, calculated together, will be taken into account. **The applicants/s must reside/work in the area or be from a feeder zone school to be considered for exemption.** Please note that residence learners do not qualify to apply for exemption from school fees.
 - i. Should there be a dispute on our statement of account the parents are responsible for notifying the office (school fee department) in writing.
4. Parents must ensure that the learner's school fee account is up to date before the learner embarks on outings/school tours, as tour costs do not form part of school fees. Any payment made by the parents shall first be allocated to school fees and only once all school fees are paid up to date, shall payments be allocated according to the direction of the parents.
5. Parents must give notice in writing of any intention to remove their child from the school and furthermore to return any books and/or equipment belonging to the school which the learner may have.
6. We understand that the school reserves the right to verify all information supplied to them via our application. In the event of fraudulent documents being submitted, the school reserves the right to lay criminal charges of fraud against any of the parties to the application. The school may supply any default information to, or conduct a credit enquiry and/or credit information search in respect of the parents/ guardians with a credit bureau, or persons acting as their agents/or other credit grantors.
7. The signatory/ies hereto hereby choose/s their email address as their chosen address for service and delivery of all documents, correspondence) as indicated in the application for admission. In the event of a change of email address, parents are to notify the school in writing within three (3) days.
8. This commitment in its entirety will be valid from the day on which it is signed by "the parent" to the day on which the learner officially leaves the school.
9. The person or parent signing this agreement confirms that they fully understand the terms of the agreement and that they have regard to all the terms and conditions stipulated above.
