SCHOOL FEES 2022

TERMS AND CONDITIONS REGARDING SCHOOL FEES

1. a. Biological/adoptive parents and who have legal custody and / or legal Guardianship or
b. a friend, family of the parent (including, but not limited to a person who enrolls the learner) in respect of a learner are regarded as "parents" of the learner as envisaged in the South African Schools Act, being the person who undertakes to fulfil the obligations of a person referred to above, towards the learner's education at school. The word "parent" contained in this agreement, shall also include parents and person or persons liable for the payment of school fees.
2. We jointly and severally undertake to pay school fees and understand the following :
 - a. The annual school fees will be a compulsory sum per annum as adopted by the majority of parents at the AGM held in November.
 - b. In terms of family law, parents are jointly and severally liable for the payment of the school fees, irrespective of their marital status.
 - c. In the event of non-payment of school fees, the school will institute legal action against both parents irrespective of maintenance and court orders which may exist between the parties.
 - d. In terms of Section 39 of the South African Schools Act, parents are liable to pay compulsory school fees.
 - e. In terms of Section 40 and 41 of the South African Schools Act, the school may enforce the payment of these compulsory fees.
 - f. If parents fail to meet their school fee obligations, the school may record this non- performance with a registered credit bureau and the parents or persons who are liable for the payment of school fees consents to this information being so reported.
 - g. The parties to this application undertake to pay all legal costs, on an **attorney-and-client** basis, interest including attorney / client fees and collection costs incurred by the school, in the event of the school having to take legal action for the recovery of school fees.
 - h. Parents who are unable to pay school fees may apply for exemption of these fees. Applications must be submitted annually to the Chairperson of the Governing Body during **Term 1**. Parents will be interviewed by members of the School Governing Body. Please note that residence learners **DO NOT QUALIFY** for exemption from school fees. The "combined annual gross income of parents" must be taken into consideration when considering an application for exemption. This means that the annual gross income of the parents, calculated together, will be taken into account.
 - i. Should there be a dispute on our statement of account we are responsible for notifying the office (school fee department) in writing.
3. Parents have to ensure that the learner's school fee account is up to date before the learner embarks on school tours, as tour costs do not form part of school fees.
4. Parents must give notice in writing of any intention to remove their child from the school and furthermore to return any books and/or equipment belonging to the school which the learner may have.
5. We understand that the school reserves the right to verify all information supplied to them via our application. In the event of fraudulent documents being submitted, the school reserves the right to lay criminal charges of fraud against any of the parties to the application. The school may conduct a credit enquiry and/or credit information search in respect of the parents/ guardians with a credit bureau, or persons acting as their agents/or other credit grantors.
6. The signatory/ies hereto hereby choose/s domicilium citandi et executandi (address for service and delivery of all documents, correspondents and legal processes) as indicated in the application for admission. In the event of a change of address, parents are to notify the school in writing within three (3) days.
7. This commitment in its entirety will be valid from the day on which it is signed by "the parent" to the day on which the learner officially leaves the school.
8. The person or parent signing this agreement confirms that they fully understand the terms of the agreement and that they have regard to all the terms and conditions stipulated above.

ABRIDGED CODE OF CONDUCT
SCHOOL DISCIPLINE:

K.H.S. school rules apply en route to and from school, at school and on any excursion where the learner represents the school, and/or is recognisable as a learner of K.H.S.

Whilst at school, a learner is subject to the applicable school rules. In terms of school policy, the punishment must fit the offence and be reasonable.

Behaviour which is socially unacceptable will not be tolerated. Abuse in any form will not be permitted.

Should the language or conduct of a learner be deemed to be of such a nature as to endanger the maintenance of a proper standard of moral conduct, the discipline or social well-being of the school, such conduct may result in detention, suspension and/or expulsion of the learner. The regulation can apply to a single act or series of acts, according to the school's Code of Conduct.

SCHOOL RULES:

Transgression of the following school rules is viewed in a very serious light and will be dealt with in terms of the Code of Conduct:

1. Use of alcohol on school property; the buying and selling thereof
2. Use of any narcotic substances; the buying and selling thereof
3. Smoking at school / in school uniform off the campus
4. Repeated truancy from school
5. Violence of any nature
6. Bringing weapons/dangerous toys to school
7. Any form of disruption of the teaching process
8. Any form of theft

Respect for the authority of the school and its rules and regulations governing discipline, behaviour, appearance and cleanliness of the learners is required from both parents and learners.

We expect that respect for the school and other people's property will be acknowledged by all. This includes scaling the school fence.

DRESS CODE

UNIFORM

BOYS: Grey school flannels which may not be tapered, white shirt, blazer, school tie, black lace-up school shoes, grey school socks, plain grey or black belt with plain buckle. No jewellery permitted.

GIRLS: (Summer) School regulation skirt or trousers, white shirt (short or long-sleeved), school tie, white socks, school shoes (lace up or single strap), blazer.
(Winter) School regulation skirt, or tailored grey trousers with attached belt as specified by supplier, white shirt, school tie, black tights, school shoes, school jersey and blazer, grey school socks when wearing trousers.
No jewellery permitted except for sleepers/gold or silver studs in girls' ears. (one pair).

GENERAL APPEARANCE

BOYS: Hair: Neatly cut, tapered into the neck, conforming to the shape of the head. Not covering ears or eyes. No steps. No unconventional hairstyles permitted. Only natural colour hair is permitted. Clean shaven.

GIRLS: Hair: Neat and tidy. Long hair tied back. No outlandish styles. Natural colour. No make-up.

GENERAL

E-LEARNING

Every learner will be required to have an electronic tablet with at least the following specifications:

Type of Tablet: Any android tablet that complies with the minimum specifications is preferred. Apple tablets and tablets running Microsoft Windows 8 or 10 can also be used, but are not recommended.

Processor Type: Processor Type: Android 4.1 (Jelly Bean) or later.

Processor Speed: Processor Speed: At least a 1,3 GHz Dual-Core Processor. Anything faster is better.

Connectivity: The tablet must have Wi-Fi. Mobile data is not required. Screen Size: 7 inches or larger (10 inches is preferred).

RAM At least 1 GB RAM (instant memory) is required. More is better.

ROM: At least 8 GB ROM (storage space) is needed. More is better.

Battery Life: The battery should last at least 5 — 7 hours on a full charge. A power pack can be used to extend battery life.

General

- Krugersdorp High School does NOT supply any learner with a tablet.
- Text books that are loaded onto the tablet will have to be purchased by the parent through the school. All additional notes, lesson plans, movie clips, resource material, etc. loaded onto the tablet will be provided by educators free of charge.
- Every text book purchased is activated by a password which can only be used on ONE device.
- Parents are responsible for insuring their child's tablet against breakage and theft. The school will never be responsible for the safekeeping of your child's tablet.
- A cover and screen protector for the tablet is highly recommended, to protect against scratches and damage.

BOOKS: Textbooks are supplied by the school. These must be returned at the end of the year. All textbooks are required to be reinforced and covered. Stationery is supplied by the parents/learners as per stationery list.

SCHOOL FEES: Compulsory as per South African School's Act. See attached 2021 school fee structure plus terms and conditions.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE: Parents/Guardians are responsible for a child's attendance at school.

- School attendance is compulsory until the end of the year in which a child turns 15 or until the end of Grade 9.
- Parents are to notify the school per telephone if a learner is absent and to follow this up with a letter to the register teacher.
- Absence during examinations, cycle tests and all school-based assessment tasks: medical certificate may be required.

MESSAGES: The office does **NOT** relay messages to learners except in a case of extreme emergency.

TRANSPORT: Krugersdorp High School does not supply any form of transport to and from school in the mornings and afternoons.

The stipulations of The South African Schools Act No. 84 of 1996 are applicable and a copy of the said Act will be made available on request.
